By the way, the easiest way to undo a run is to use the find command from your Journal folder. Location of the Journal folder in iCloud is usually ~/Library/Mobile Documents/5U8NS4GX82~com~dayoneapp~dayone/Documents/Journal\_dayone.

```
find . -newerct '10 minutes ago' -type f
```

Will show you what files were just created in the last 10 minutes.

```
find . -newerct '10 minutes ago' -type f -exec rm {} \;
```

will delete just those files. It's faster than manually deleting them in Day One by far.
